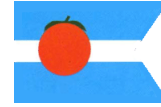

Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club conducts monthly Regattas from March through November. Other sailing opportunities exist throughout the year including informal "pick up" races on Wednesday evenings followed by informal get-togethers at Round Table Pizza and summer "raft ups" followed by BYO-BBQs in July & August. (See the attached Sailing Schedule for more details.)

No boat? No problem! LMVYC has a fleet of Sabots, Balboa 13's, Lasers, CFJ's and the Lake's Catalina Expo 14.2 boats available for your sailing enjoyment! Free lessons are also provided to new members by appointment throughout the summer. Contact our sailing instructor at sailing-instructor@lmvyc.org.

In the true sense of Corinthian sailing, our goal at LMVYC is to promote sailing, to encourage good fellowship among yachtsmen afloat and ashore, and to introduce non-boat owning amateur sailors young and old to the sport of sailing. Informal sailing lessons are provided free of charge to new members.

Membership Categories:

Regular Members can take advantage of our reciprocal program with other Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA) clubs. They have voting privileges in club elections and participate in club activities and may serve on all club committees in which they have an interest. Regular membership includes entry fees for all our regattas, refreshments and food served after regattas; free rental sail boats (Expo 14.2) on regatta days, for Wednesday sunset sailing during daylight saving time and on Friday afternoons in July and August. **Regular members are obligated to serve a turn as hospitality crew for two to three hours approximately once every two years.**

Associate Members enjoy the same racing and reciprocal privileges at other SCYA clubs as regular members but forfeit all other club privileges and responsibilities. They are welcome to join in regattas and before- or after-regatta meals but will be charged normal guest fees.

Membership Dues:

Annual dues are \$85 for Regular and Associate memberships and are payable each January. Dues for new members are prorated based on the date of application: Jan-Mar. \$85; Apr-Jun \$60; Jul-Sep \$40; Oct-Dec \$15. There is an initiation fee of \$25 for new memberships.
