I agree to comply with all rules and sailing instructions governing the race and the Lake Mission Viejo Association rules. I enter at my own risk and will not hold the officers or race committee of the Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club, or the Lake Mission Viejo Association, its officers, directors, employees or any other party affiliated with races, responsible for any damage accident or injury to myself or my crew, family or guests, or my property, including my boat.

I verify that I can swim, and that I and my crew will wear USCG approved lifejackets while on my boat when Y signal is posted. I also certify that my boat is insured. I, my crew, or anyone in my party (guest) will be responsible for damage to Lake Mission Viejo Association or Lake Mission Viejo Yacht Club property or facilities.

All Junior Sailors must wear USCG approved lifejackets at all times when on the water!

A race sailed under Corinthian principles is simultaneously a competitive and a cooperative venture: competitive, because everybody wants to do their best, and cooperative, because we all rely on each other to obey the rules and voluntarily take a penalty when we either realize or are reminded that we've broken one.

LMVYC Code of Conduct

1. Learn and sail by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
2. Never use the RRS as a "weapon"- the RRS are there to avoid collisions and damage, not to help the "expert" win races.
3. Help less skilled or new members with technical problems, sailing techniques and understanding the RRS. Talk about these things with understanding, and respect.
4. Call infractions by hailing twice, "Protest" and the "Sail Number".
5. If you are the one protested, acknowledge. Penalty turns must be performed as soon as possible.
6. Follow the Corinthian Spirit and do penalty turns, even when not protested. Even if the infraction "did not hurt" another competitor - do the penalty
7. Refrain at all times from making either derogatory or demeaning remarks, be friendly and courteous.
8. Remember, this sport will not be a fun sport, unless and until we are good sportsmen.
